## 4. CURRENT PLAN

Went over the Valley View Trust Fund Goals for things year

- Goal #1 (Language arts based goal)
  - <u>GOAL -80% of students in kindergarten to 3rd grade will show typical to</u> <u>well above typical growth according to the pathways of progress on the</u> <u>end-of-year Acadience assessment.</u>
  - We test and take measurements then decide action steps based on the measurements
  - The State is using LETTERS to teach reading to students. It's based on lots of research
  - ValleyView teachers K-3 have to be certified by law in the LETTERS course.
  - All but one of ValleyViews teachers have finished or are finishing the Letters course
  - You are allowed 2 years to finished the program
  - Research has proven that collaboration with the entire staff is very effective. For example, think of each student being viewed as all the staff's students, not just a particular teacher's student, because the entire school is working together to help each student.
  - If you look around the school you'll see progress boards for each grade as a visual reminder to the entire staff each day about the student's progress.
  - Paraprofessionals will provide small group intervention & enrichment support in kindergarten through third grade. (\$22,000.00). (Taken from website)
- Goal #2 (Math based goals)
  - <u>80% of our students, K-6th grade, will show typical growth according our</u> personalized learning software, IXL.
  - The school pays for IXL to help each kids on their own level
  - Paraprofessionals will provide small group intervention & enrichment support in kindergarten through third grade. (\$22,000.00). (taken from website)
  - Students will receive supplemental math instruction, practice, and support with the personalized learning program IXL (\$2503.00). (Taken from Website)

We talked about expenditures for IXL, Zearn, Chromebook leases (these rotate every 4 years) and classroom tech (smart boards) on top of that of the teacher training and hiring of paraprofessionals to help with math and reading goals.
