- Set Goals

As a council after reviewing the data we had an unanimous vote to have a math goal \& reading goal as follows:

- $70 \%$ of students in kindergarten to 6th grade will show typical to well above typical growth according to the pathways of progress on the end-of-year 2023-2024 Acadience READING Assessment.
- $70 \%$ of students in kindergarten to 6th grade will show typical to well above typical growth according to the pathways of progress on the end-of-year 2023-2024 Acadience MATH Assessment.

As a school we currently have a goal to show a $5 \%$ decrease in chronic absenteeism (18 days or more) comparing 2023 attendance data with 2024 attendance data. We mentioned several things we are doing to encourage good attendance including a monthly traveling trophy, classroom incentives, parent attendance meetings/ contracts, \& Kami, our student advocate making phone calls and meeting with individual students doing prize punch cards with students.

Today is the 107th day of school. There are 180 school days in the year. Missing 10\%, 18 days or more for any reason is considered excessive.

We currently have 313 students. As of today we have 101 students who have missed 11 or more school days. We have 37 students who have missed 18 or more school days. We have 10 students who have missed 25 or more school days. 1 student who has missed 36 or more days.

Last school year we had 341 students. 110 students missed 18 or more school days last year. 58 students missed 25 or more days last year. 26 students missed 36 or more days.
